



Registration Criteria

- 1. Helmets must be worn by driver and passenger when motorcycles are underway.
- 2. No consumption of any alcoholic beverages during the ride. Alcohol is permitted once motorcycles are parked for the evening.
- 3. All participants <u>must attend</u> the Safety Briefing on Sunday evening, July 16th held at Horicon Post 157, 735 S Hubbard St, Horicon, WI, at 6:00 PM.
- 4. Every Registration <u>must include</u> a completed copy of the <u>Medical Information</u>

 <u>Form</u> and have it Sunday evening.
- 5. Kick-Stands-Up on 7/17 will be @ 8:00 AM at Juneau Post. KSU 7/18 @ 8:00 AM; KSU 7/19 @ 7:00 AM.
- 6. One fuel stop is planned for each day. We will do "community" fueling and each motorcycle will "round-up" to the nearest whole dollar. Please have ample ones and fives (\$1.00 & \$5.00) to avoid unnecessary delays. Change will not be given. Please have a full tank at the start of each day.
- 7. Flags mounted to motorcycles may not exceed 11" x 15". Flags can be USA, Legion Rider, POW/MIA, CMA, or any branch of the military.
- 8. If you are unable to ride the entire 3 days and wish to ride one/two, let us know in advance so you can receive the Safety Briefing before joining the ride.
- 9. If a motorcycle experiences mechanical difficulties, or, if the driver/passenger must pull to the roadside for any reason, the main body will continue moving forward. There will be medical and mechanical support within the ride to assist you.
- 10. No political flags, emblems and/or placards will be allowed.
