VCF also funds training for Legion's accredited veteran service officers who are continuously working more than 750,000 benefits claims for disabled veterans and their families, free of charge.

Auxiliary Badger Girls State Program: American Legion Auxiliary Badger Girls State is a program sponsored by the American Legion Auxiliary. Girls State is not a recreational program it is a government and leadership conference where the entire delegation will create a mythical fifty-first state that functions according to the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

Operation A.L.F.: One of the goals of the Sons of The American Legion has always been to support our active-duty military. Over the past few years, they have been privileged to participate in pre-deployment ceremonies for service members heading to duty in far away places, far from their loved ones by providing their children with comfort puppies to keep them company while mom and dad are away.
